YOU HAVE AN ACTIVE ASYLUM CLAIM IF...

you're waiting for a decision, either:

- after an initial asylum claim
- after an appeal against a negative decision, or
- after a fresh claim.

YOU DO NOT HAVE AN ACTIVE ASYLUM CLAIM IF...

your asylum claim has been rejected and you have not yet appealed against the decision.

THIS MEANS THAT APPROXIMATELY 400 ASYLUM SEEKERS IN GLASGOW ARE AT RISK OF BEING EVICTED FROM THEIR HOMES.

HAVE YOU RECEIVED A LETTER TELLING YOU THAT YOUR SUPPORT WILL BE STOPPED? IF SO:

- 1. DON'T LET MEARS TRICK YOU INTO LEAVING YOUR HOME VOLUNTARILY.**
Mears cannot evict you from your home. Mears must get a Sheriff's court order. This takes time.
- 2. GET IN TOUCH WITH YOUR LAWYER.**
Make sure that they are aware of the situation and seek their advice as soon as possible.
- 3. CONTACT THE SCOTTISH REFUGEE COUNCIL FOR LEGAL ADVICE AND SUPPORT.** We can help you with this referral if you would like.
- 4. GET IN TOUCH WITH ASH PROJECT.**
We can monitor Mears' behaviour and offer housing advice and support.
